Humane Society Fundraiser!

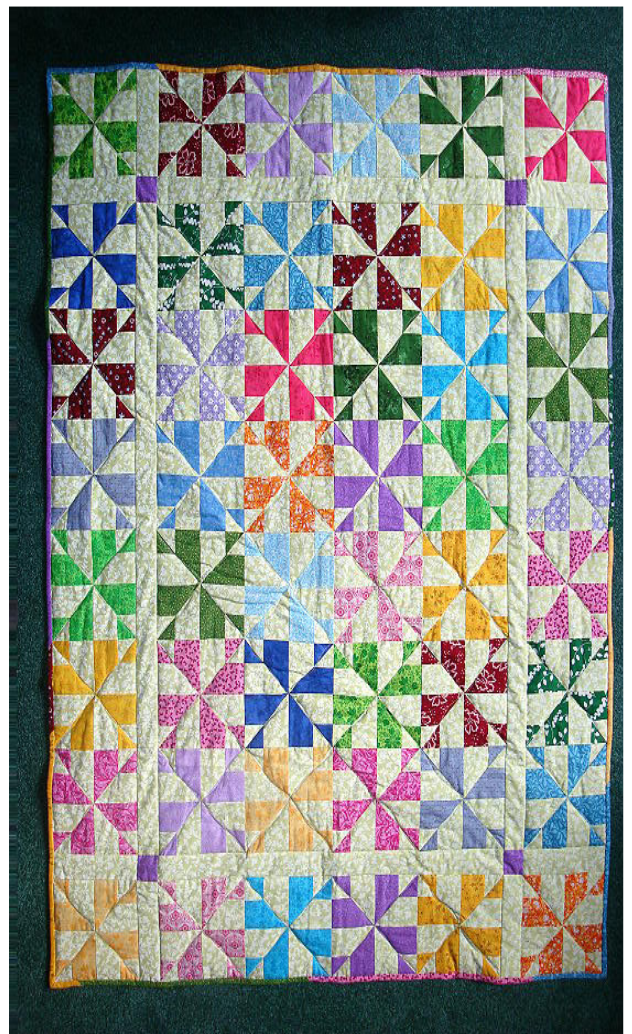
- Many of you have adopted "new family members" from the Humane Society!

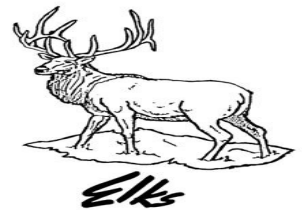


